Chapter 2 - Fear, reverence and irreverence

In the early stages of the journey, reverence may come coupled with fear. Rightly so, in the beginning fear is invoked as an emotion to keep the ego in check.

However, as one advances in their journey, overcoming their egoic tendencies with a humbled self – fear (if still present) would indicate silent presence of the ego resulting in great irreverence.

Before knowing someone, it is natural to be afraid. But once you come to know them, and learning about their loving nature, fear should have no place.

If it persists, it signals a lack of trust, hesitation, and subtle fear from a subtly hidden ego.

If you come to know the Truth About The Protective And Caring Nature Of The Divine Mother Maa DhumaVati Towards devotees, and if you have acted with integrity, truthfulness and honesty, is there any reason for you to fear the Mother Of Universe?

Even if it seems to you that The Divine Mother Has Delivered

Punishment, you must know that there is a reason your lifestory needs to go through that journey – either for learning a wisdom or breaking through from some limitation – and what appears as a punishment in the outside, is undoubtedly A Form Of Grace By Maa DhumaVati.

Human ego of the human mind defies and creates resistance the moment it sees something not going the way it 'wants'. If you are sincere in your journey and can overcome ego's wants, you can break away from such resistance and go beyond your present limitations.

Resistance of "the self" - the ego

The moment you recognize your wrongdoing and anticipate punishment, the ego - acting as a defence mechanism - begins to negotiate. It feels attacked, and it resists.

The self emerges, especially in matters of penance, particularly when the crime and its punishment seem unjust. In such cases, the ego, even when transcended through spirituality, rises in opposition. This revolt occurs, whether consciously or not, because logic, as perceived by the ego, cannot reconcile what feels excessive and non-logical to it.

In fact, non-logical it is. At the outset of the seeker's journey, things seem clear and logical, but as you move forward, increasingly non-logical elements arise. This is an inevitable phase. In the search for truth, if one insists on validating everything through sensory logic, they remain bound by the body and mind.

Logical, Illogical and Non-Logical

Does this mean you must become irrational? Rather the contrary. Logic is dependent on limited memory-set within the mind. On your journey towards transcendence of the limited mind, you will have experiences and gain insights that may seem illogical. But it is only illogical to the mind's limited approaches being based on information that is outside mind's paradigms. These are what you may refer to as non-logical – i.e. the logic of such experiences and events remains a mystery to the mind, as they are based on 'Something Cosmic'.

On your journey towards self-discovery, you may often have to embrace the non-logical when necessary if you want to go deeper with your experience.

The bridge called "courage"

While overcoming challenges from the ego, often you will have to cross the bridge of 'courage'. These are micro-moments of your life where important determinative battles are fought between your discerning mind and the ego. At those moments, if you want to overcome your egoic limited mind, you must cross the bridge of courage. looking neither left nor right; moving forward, beyond the limitations of the narrowly logical mind.

For many, the narrow logic of the senses, tied to the ego, will seem like a saviour, drawing them back.

They remain stuck in this rudimentary logic, continually wrestling with themselves, unable to cross the threshold. They will be negotiating and wrestling the whole time with themselves. Stuck in that logical layer. They even use logic to discuss things non-logical, but always retaining the "logic" hat on. The rudimentary logical structure. Never ever have they crossed the bridge though.

They say things, but don't allow non-logical output, as per their definition of their logic. Rudimentary logic. Continuing to abide by it, will by definition keep being bounded by fear. Irreverential.

The Divine Design

Fear arises from the unknown. But once you recognize the presence of a deeper intelligence – A Divine Structure That Underlies experience – fear should no longer hold sway. To see that there Is A Divine Design is to understand that even what appears "broken" from your limited perspective, is part of a larger, interconnected whole. The chaos and disorder you perceive are elements of a structure that you may not yet grasp. With this understanding, fear dissolves, replaced by a reassurance that what unfolds, however mysterious, is part Of The Divine Design.

It's like an old building that must be demolished to make way for something new. The unfolding drama might say, "You broke the law; this building must come down." But For The Divine Design To Manifest, this cycle of transgression and consequence - of breaking down and rebuilding – must play out. We fear destruction, trapped by language that frames it as something negative. Yet, it's part of A Greater Process, One That we often fail to see from our limited perspective.

Language can be a prison. It shapes our perception, delivering verdicts that lock us into assumptions.

In some cultures, such as the Mapuche tribe in Chile, fear does not exist as a concept, as we know it. With a high degree of consistency and clarity they describe fear as having no value. They don't understand it as a concept. The wiring of their brain by their cultural norms, recognise instead the concept "I feel respect". They have the understanding that all elements of the universe are interconnected and deserve unconditional respect. They give reverence to the air, water and land, along with all the living creatures that inhabit these spaces.

Feeling fear only gets in the way, stifling our openness and curiosity about the possibilities of the situation. Fearlessness is what yog (union) seeks. Such fearlessness exists only in the complete calm that can no longer be shaken by events expected of the future.

Hence, the fear becomes irreverential because it stops the communication channel with The Divine.

Understanding dissolves fear

Fear is a basic mechanism, triggered by the unknown. But once something is understood, fear should give way to clarity. Only the awareness of the nature of its mechanism remains.

Consider a tiger cub learning from its mother. At first, the cub may irrationally fear the power and unpredictability of the mother's strength. But over time, as the cub grows and understands, that fear dissolves. The mother tiger does not act out of malice – but out of love. The cub comes to see this.

In the same way, understanding the nature - the dharma of any force, whether external or within, brings peace. The tiger mother doesn't harm out of cruelty; she protects, she teaches, she embodies her role. And just as the cub learns to respect and love this process, you too must learn to align with the natural flow of life. Irrational fear is replaced by reverence, by an understanding that we are part of something larger.

You will still take precautions – just as the cub instinctively avoids danger—but without irrational fear. With wisdom and love, you recognize that you are part of the process, not separate from it.

Ascending through The Non-Logic

As the mind ascends to higher realms, it has glimpses of realisation that The Divine Operates on projections beyond conventional rules of logic. But for those who remain anchored to simplistic reasoning, these shifts are not just difficult – they're threatening. The mind clings to its familiar structure, believing it offers stability. Yet, it is this very attachment that blinds us to the larger reality. To see the world clearly, we must be willing to let go of the frameworks that keep us small.

Ultimately, the journey toward understanding The Cosmic transcends the boundaries of logic, as we know it. Fear, born out of ignorance, must dissolve as knowledge deepens, replaced by a reverence for the inherent Greater-logical order of the universe - which is not easily understood by the narrow logical mind. Clinging to rudimentary frameworks of thought—where every event must be dissected through logical reasoning—imprisons the mind within a limited understanding of existence.

To step beyond is to acknowledge That Truth In Its Purest Form Is Not Always Confined To the senses or to what is comfortably logical. It requires the courage to embrace the Unknown, the Non-Logical, The Ever-Mysterious and That Divine Drama Often Defies human reasoning.

In the end, it is not fear that sustains us, but an unwavering trust in the processes of life, even when they appear chaotic or destructive. The eruption of the volcano, the seeming injustice of punishment—these are not forces to be feared but aspects of A Divine Order the mind may yet be able to fully comprehend.

Only by surrendering To The Greater Wisdom, letting go of the ego's resistance, and recognizing our place in the larger order of existence, can we attain true fearlessness.

To know The Divine Design, is not to master the understanding with limited logic of the mind, but to become one with Its Unfolding, accepting creation, destruction and evolution as necessary elements of a Greater Design.

Chapter 3 - Reborn - The Starter is not the finisher

When a devotee enters the path of seeking, it often begins with an appeal, a request. As long as there is an ask, it indicates a reliance on logic to check the fulfilment of that request. The seeker, after all, will inevitably measure what they receive against their own idea of what is best.

But how does one measure? Through a rudimentary framework of logic.

The problem lies in the fact that you use the same limited framework to judge the outcome or measure the effect – if any. This engagement with the ego-based assessment is the root of all problems. While walking on this path of inner-discovery, you should not have any expectations - as any expectations will be based on the narrow periphery of the limited logical mind.

What is often overlooked or not realised is the fact that: **The one who begins the journey is not the one who completes it.**

Don't Empty the cup - beginning of the seeker's journey

The seeker who begins the journey - driven by curiosity and the limited understanding of the body and mind - is not the same at the journey's end.

At the outset, scepticism and logic are not only helpful but necessary. The seeker brings their "cup"—a metaphor for the limited framework of understanding rooted in the body and mind—to the vast ocean of Divine Wisdom.

This cup is essential in the early stages; it's the only means by which you can grasp the sheer scale of the ocean.

In the beginning, the cup is all you have. It's your framework for interpreting reality. You need to fill that cup, because without it, you lack the ability to even perceive the ocean for what it is. Only through this framework can you begin to appreciate the enormity and power of the ocean.

But in the process, your framework will be tested – and ultimately, it must break. Letting go of this framework prematurely, without pushing it to its limits, is self-deception. You can't discard what hasn't been fully examined and broken. You need to bring your own limited understanding – your "cup" – to the process, because without it, there's no comparison, no grounding in the physical.

Without bringing your own cup you do not know. You need the physical body and its framework to compare and understand through. Everything has to be compared and contextuated with the processing capacity of that machine.

Without the physical, there is no need for understanding – no vacuum to create a sense of necessity. This necessity, or "necessitation," is a function of processing power. But what is necessitating? A machine somewhere – a body, a hardware interface. Understanding arises because there's a framework demanding it. Without that framework, the need itself dissolves.

Logic reaches its limit

So this limitation of the cup, its narrowness of vision through which it can quantify. For its quantification's sake it has to be drawn upon the realisation that no cup can quantify the ocean. Billion years would be needed.

And then, only then, you start having an initial quantification of the ocean. Once the quantification is there, the cup can be thrown away.

You start realising: The starter cannot be the finisher.

The logic of the assessor is the armament of the seeker starting the search. If the finisher is a different entity, that armament, that rudimentary logic framework, that cup, will not be there anymore, because the finisher is not the starter entity.

That will be possible only if something has changed in the middle.

The biggest impediment to understand this change is your relying on the starter.

Starter is a sceptic. asks 'questions and opposes new ideas all the time. Who in their right mind will expect that what you have treasured, the best servant ever, to be abandoned?

Scepticism is what started you into this journey of seeking and has served you best ever since. Later on when you are asked to, taught to transcend all your sceptic capabilities. It doesn't feel right.

But for who? For the ego layers. For them it doesn't feel right. The sceptic who got you started will stop your process.

The Non-Logic Makes Use of the logic

The non-logical welcomes rudimentary logic – to a point. That logic is the fuel for the rocket, essential to start the journey, but eventually left behind. Just as the rocket discards its fuel tank, The Greater Logic relies on basic logic initially yet transcends it beyond a certain stage. Basic logic is used to begin with, to assess and measure everything. Later on, you are asked, assess the outcome not the path.

By that time, after seeing the outcomes you should have the reverence to see that this path cannot be conceived with rudimentary logic.

The seeker must take the cup, compare it to the ocean, and then, in full awareness of the ocean's depth and magnitude, discard the cup. If you persist in measuring the ocean with your cup, you will only prolong the process indefinitely, measuring the immeasurable with an inadequate tool.

Once you recognize the limitations of logic, the possibilities open up. A new dimension of understanding unfolds.

And then, anything goes.

Ye, the ego driven mind might still ask:

"How can I be sure? How can I trust without knowing?"

The answer lies in a deeper knowledge:

"If you know The Divine Mother, you know you Will Be Given". How does this courage come? Who will be able to do it and how?

Only when the soul, - the layer beyond intuition- is ready.

The layer beyond intuition gives you The Wisdom That The Divine Mother Is There.

Zero doubt and confusion.

Then, you get to cross that 'bridge of courage'.

A Path only for the courageous

The courage is not only about you initiating this process. The continuing of the process requires even greater courage as you move forward. You must walk without certainty, without knowing if the knowledge you seek will ever fully reveal itself.

That is a big differentiator.

True courage means accepting that, yes, the entire trajectory might seem wrong. And it will definitely seem wrong when accessing through rudimentary logic.

Trajectory though is never wrong when accessing from The Greater Logic. Can never be possible.

Your role and purpose come from The Higher Logic and never understood from rudimentary logic. When your time is ripe, it is as Calculated By The Higher Logic.

Don't let the ego get in between. Whenever ego is assessing something, ego wants. It wants security, safety. Yet when one is Blessed to see beyond the ego, they find themselves unmoved by the illusions of fear.

Why? Because of absolute trust In The Divine Mother.

With trust In The Divine Mother, no event can be considered inauspicious – accidents, discomfort, even death lose their negative connotations. Embracing the unknown with faith, you abandon the comforts of certainty.

Only then will you be transformed from seeker to knower and discover The True Nature Of The Divine Journey.

Chapter 4 - Forms Of The Formless

As the seeker moves beyond the limits of narrow logic and into the deeper realms of greater logic with trust and surrender, the journey brings Greater meaning, Greater realisation. As the Divine Cosmic Wisdom Is Transmuted into the confines of the limited periphery of the narrow mind - As The Divine Becomes Visible.

Formless Can Take Form

As the seeker approaches The Divine Formless with a highdegree of sincerity and devotion, the realisation and recognition transforms The Divine Formless Into Divine Form – perceivable to the full faculties of the senses, digestible for the mind's symbols, vocabulary, and languages.

Without sincerity and devotion in their active engagement, even the most profound potential remains dormant – like a powerful machine left unused. If you have a computer but do not interact with it, it remains an unused object, without any significance. What good is that knowledge if you never access it? The same principle applies to your journey of seeking.

You may possess the knowledge of reaching The Divine, but without your active involvement, it is meaningless. Knowing the road isn't enough. You must walk. Each step taken with reverence and intention shapes the unfolding of your journey.

The Divine Is Ever-Present, Formless, Yet Responding To your engagement, sincerity and reverence, – May Choose To Manifest With A Form In The Divine Play.

The 'seers' Of Forms

In ancient times, seers and sages possessed the unique ability to perceive The Divine Formless As Powerful Forms - As Is The Divine Form Of

Maa Maha Kaali.

Providing a way for people to approach The Divine Through Forms, the seers, practising dharmic principals rooted in absolute truth, gained an extraordinary clarity About The Forms Which The Formless Assumed.

Such Is A Divine Cosmic Form Of Maa DhumaVati. Revealed to the seers, throughout time immemorial.

Blessed By The Divine, seers were able to introduce Cosmic Divine Forms to the masses in 'More Relatable, Tangible Form'.

The sages, with their profound understanding, defined The Divine Forms That Spoke to human perception, enabling people to find solace in them. The Forms Were Supreme Embodiment Of The Divine, often perceived as Fierce, Yet Remaining Eternally Loving, Compassionate - Allowing devotees to realise the Divine Forms easily in a relatable way.

Mother of sage ramakrishna

Is The Divine Limited To Specific Forms?

The Divine Is Formless.

However, human mind is bound by limitations, often it requires symbolisms, metaphorical meaning, and physical Forms to be able to understand, relate and connect with the Divine Supreme.

As ramakrishna, in his supreme conviction, sensitivity and with unwavering devotion, recognised The Divine As The Form Of

Maa Maha Kaali - A Form revered by the sages and realised and seen throughout ages - The Divine Mother Chose To Respond to ramakrishna's yearnings.

Through his sadhana and worship, The Divine Became Real In That Form for him. In the most concrete sense of the word.

Powerful Forms Of Divine Formless

A common misconception is that since All Forms lead to The One Source, All Manifestations Of Forms Are The Same. That assumption obscures something fundamental about the nature of consciousness: **Not all Forms are the same.**

Not Recognising The Formless Divine In The Revealed Forms to the sages, can be like dialling a wrong number – a number either unused and or never really activated – where you will never receive any response from.

It is Not that The Divine Prefers One Form Over Another – The Divine Formless Is Beyond Such Necessities.

The Divine Doesn't Need the connection – it is humans who do need such. And that connection requires humility, acceptance, openness for a inner transformation, before the connection can occur.

To enable human beings to overcome their mental and physical limitations, The Divine Has REVEALED In Specific Forms, More Approachable, Accessible, and more relatable for to humanity.


